



Welcome to We Can! Unit 1: Nice to Meet You

This short lesson is designed for a Saudi Grade 3 child using We Can Unit 1. We'll meet friendly characters, practise simple greetings, ask and answer names, talk about feelings, count to ten, learn colours, practise the short 'a' sound, play fun games, and finish with a quick review.

Meet Our Characters



Sara

Sara loves drawing and says hello with a big smile.



Ali

Ali likes football and greets friends excitedly.



Maya

Maya enjoys stories and asks polite questions.

Let's Say Hello

Key greetings to practise:

- Hello.
- Hi!
- Good morning.
- Nice to meet you.

Practice tip: Say the greeting, smile, and look at the person. Repeat with different friends.





What's Your Name?

Teach the question and short answers:

- Q: "What's your name?"
- A: "My name is Ali." / "I'm Sara."
- Polite follow-up: "Nice to meet you."

Activity: Pair practice — one child asks, the other answers. Swap roles.

How Are You? Feelings

Simple questions and answers about feelings:

- Q: "How are you?"
- A: "I'm fine, thank you." / "I'm happy." / "I'm tired."

📄 Use facial expressions to help the child connect words to feelings.





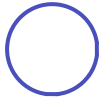
Numbers Together: 1 to 10

Teach counting with objects and actions:

1. One, two, three... up to ten.
2. Count toys, pencils, or steps.
3. Game: Count aloud as you jump or clap.

Tip: Use fingers and real objects — children remember better with movement.

Colours, Colours Everywhere



Red

Find red apples, red ball.



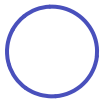
Blue

Look for blue sky, blue book.



Green

See green leaves, green bag.

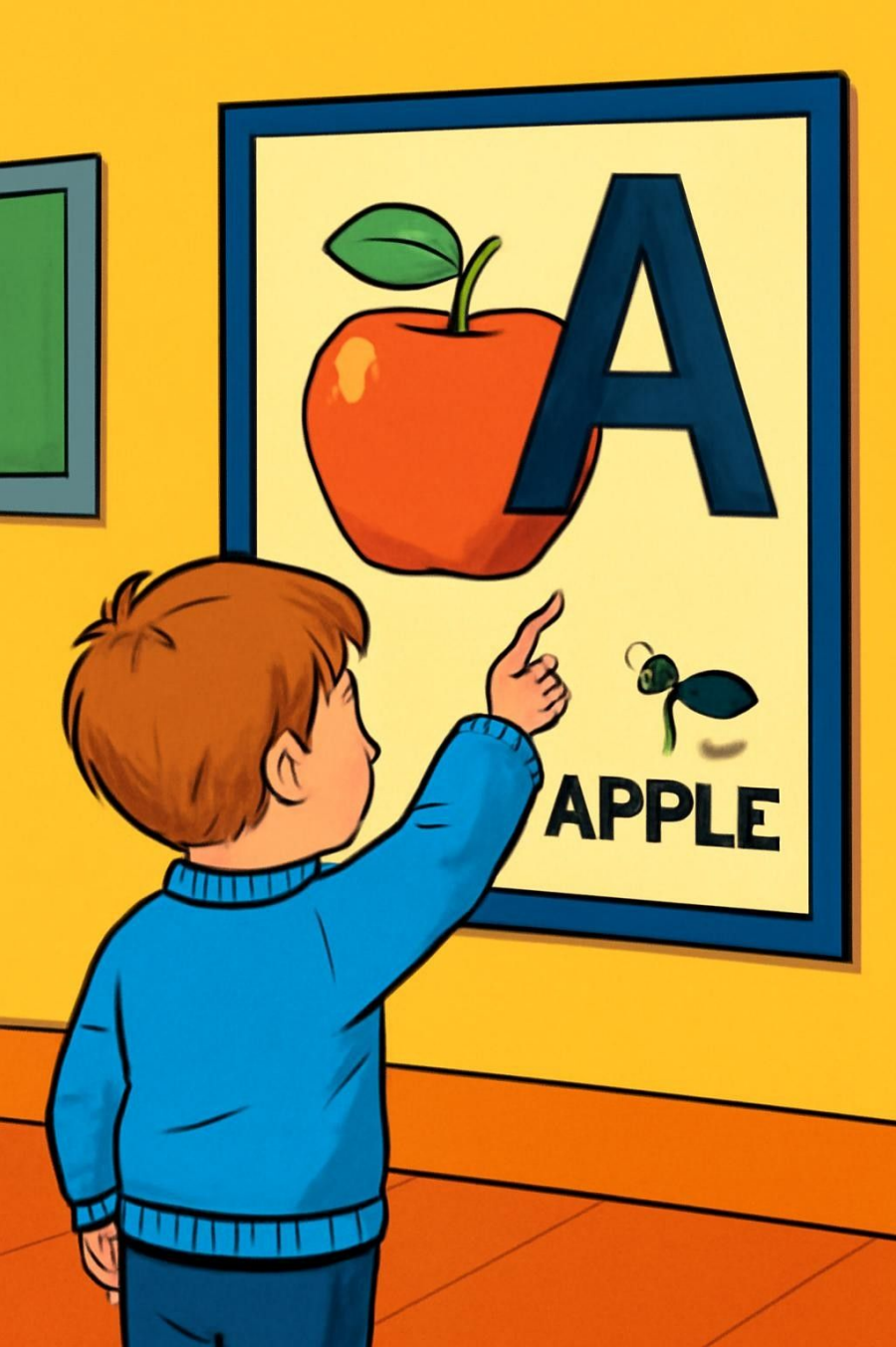


Yellow

Spot yellow sun, yellow pencil.

Activity: Colour hunt — name and touch things with each colour.





Fun with Phonics: The 'Aa' Sound

Focus: short 'a' sound as in "apple". Practice words:

- apple
- ant
- cat
- hat

Activity: Say the word, stretch the vowel: "a-a-apple". Then draw or find pictures for each word.

Let's Play! Practice Games

Greeting Match

Match greeting cards to pictures and practise saying them aloud.

Name Ball

Toss a soft ball; when you catch it say your name and "Nice to meet you."

Colour & Count Hunt

Find 3 red items, count them, and say their colours and numbers.



Your Turn! What Did You Learn Today?

Quick review — ask the child to say one item for each question:

- Say a greeting.
- Ask "What's your name?" and answer.
- Say how you feel: "I'm ____."
- Count to five out loud.
- Name two colours and one 'a' word.

✔ Give praise and a small reward for effort — this boosts confidence and enjoyment.
